

CaP Privacy Policy

Information we collect about you

All personal data is collected and stored in line with the Data Protection Act 1998. Any personal information that you provide to us will only be used for the purpose stated at the time we request it.

With your permission, we collect personal and organisational information in three ways:

- Directory, when you pass on information relating to the organisation that you are associated with and its crime and punishment collection
- CaP Alerts, where you consent to receive relevant alerts about CaP news & blogs, events, training and funding opportunities.
- Events Calendar, when passing information on to us about any relevant events that you would like us to publicise.

Personal information we collect may include: your name, title, gender; postal address, email address and phone number; and profession & associated organisation.

We will also collect and hold information about any contact you have with us relating to: event registration / attendance; dietary and access preferences or requirements; contact preferences; details of correspondence sent to you, or received from you; employment information; CaP bursary applications you have made; involvement with CaP's activities and programmes and any other information provided by yourself at the request of CaP.

What we do with personal information

Data we hold may be used by us for the following purposes:
Sending out CaP alerts relating to news, blogs, events, and training.
Analysis of CaP Network participation and interest.
Data screening to check if we have accurate contact details for you.

Sharing information

We do not disclose personal data to any third parties or external organisations. Your personal data will never be sold or passed to any third party for any other purpose.

The personal contact details you give us when attending an event may be shared with other delegates at the event. This will be basic information e.g. full name and associated organisation.
